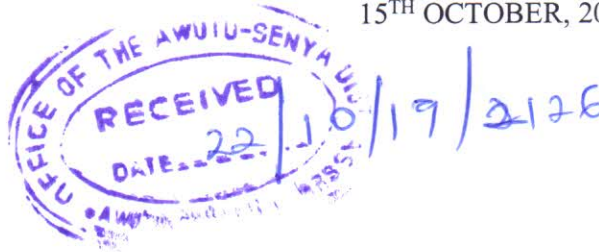

**LETTER OF PROTEST**

The leadership of Transformation Christian Church and Christian Transformation Basic School at Awutu Papaase No.1 in the Awutu Senya District of the Central Region of Ghana are protesting to your highest office against the sitting of a new Petrol Filling Station very, very close to our church and school. This Filling Station now under construction is directly sharing a fence wall with our church and school. If this Filling Station is approved and permitted to operate in that location, it will pose the greatest danger, harm and insecurity to the lives of the church members and school children and our properties.

Our church has been operating on our priority since 1997 and the school also became operational in 2004.

We are appealing to your highest office not to grant permit to this Filling Station to become operational in its present location.

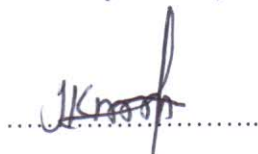
To avoid any disaster in the future our church is not in agreement of sitting this fuel station just inches from our church and school.

We have earlier protested to the E.P.A District office in Kasoa in October 2017 which led to the stop of work. Serious work has started at the same site two weeks ago.

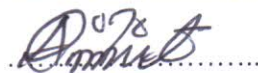
We have included three pictures as our evidence of ongoing work at the site.

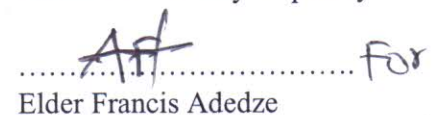
